**Register in the Parish** Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

**Certificates of Eligibility** to act as Godparent or Sponsor may be issued only to registered parishioners who have been registered here at St. John the Baptist Parish at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish. If married, your marriage must have been witnessed and blessed by a Catholic Priest or have special permission approved by the Archbishop. A person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason is not eligible to be a sponsor and, therefore, we cannot issue a Certificate of Eligibility.

**BAPTISMS:** The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday at 11:45am (immediately following the 10:30am Mass). Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

**MARRIAGE:** The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program approved by our Diocese.

### **ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

Please call the Parish Office at any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the Feast of St. John the Baptist.

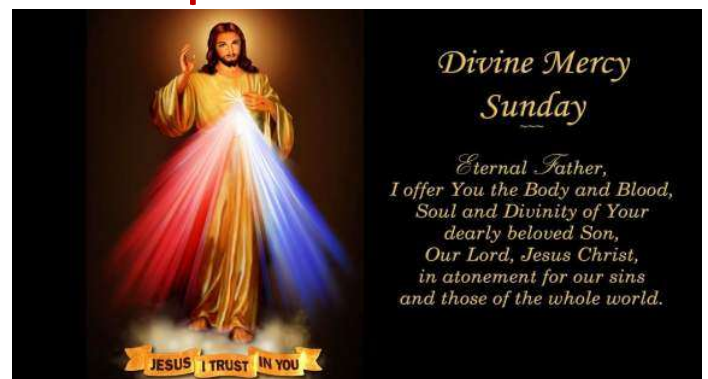

## From Your Pastor-



The readings for this Sunday show us our need for God's Divine Mercy, offered to us through the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the forgiveness

of our sins, and through each celebration of the Sacraments (all instituted to sanctify us), when we receive them in trusting Faith.

As believers, we are called to live with hope and faith in a world filled with challenges and uncertainties. The early Christian community in the Acts shows us what it means to be devoted to our faith, fellowship, and service to others. They were united in their love for God and for each other by living together and having everything in common. They broke bread and ate together with glad and sincere hearts. This coming together helped them to persevere in faith.

The First Letter of Peter reminds us that hope is not based on our circumstances, but on the unchanging promises of God. But how do we cultivate this hope and faith? The story of Thomas in the Gospel shows us that it's not about seeing or feeling God's presence, but about trusting in Jesus' words, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." Jesus has promised us the Holy Spirit. He helps us to experience God's presence in our lives. As we reflect on these passages, let's ask ourselves: Are we living with a deep sense of joy and peace, even in the midst of challenges? Are we devoted to our faith, fellowship, and service to others? May we be inspired by the examples of the early Christians and Thomas to live with hope and faith, trusting in the promises of God and sharing His love with others.

Lord, bless us so that we may receive the Holy Spirit as Jesus promised. Give us perseverance to live in faith without doubting but believing.

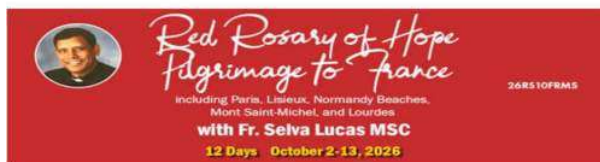
**The Evangelization Team will be having a Bake Sale on Mother's Day Weekend!**

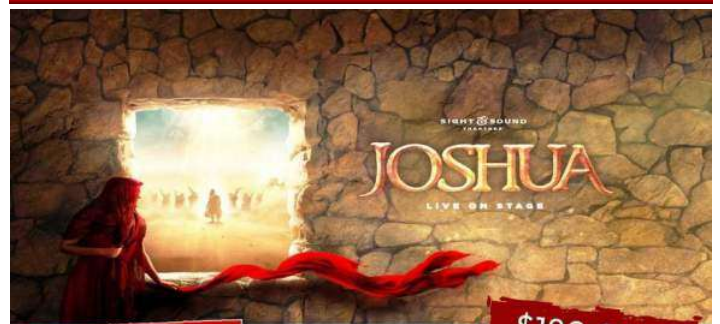

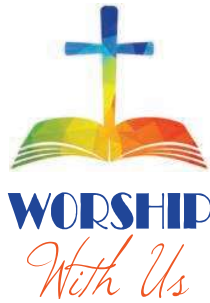


