


<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

**BAPTISMS:** The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday at

11:45am (immediately following the 10:30am Mass). Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another

parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.



### From your Pastor

Easter is the most important feast in the Church because the resurrection of Christ is the basis of our Christian faith. Resurrection of Jesus gives new meaning and direction to every Christian or the one who believes in him and follows his teachings. Experience of the risen Christ gives us the lasting peace and joy. Thus, everyday must be the day of Easter for true Christians.

Bearing witness to the risen Christ and proclaiming his Gospel to the world are the main theme of today's readings. Resurrection of Jesus is not about believing but rather living the words of Jesus. ### The Little Lambs Club



Everywhere that Jesus went, the little lambs were sure to go....

The Pastoral Council is reaching out to our parishioners to see if there is interest in bringing back "The sittle sames

club." This was brought to our attention by a few of the focus groups last year. This club was active several years ago for children from ages 3 to 1st grade. The children should be present at the beginning of the Mass until the end of the Introductory Rites, when the priest invites them to leave for their own celebration. The children are brought back to their parents immediately after the Prayers of the Faithful by a member of the liturgy team. The children are introduced to the Gospel message and Eucharistic celebration at their own level.

We are seeking two registered parishioners to take on the leadership role for each Mass (8AM & 10:30AM) on Sunday mornings. They can be young adults, parents, or older parishioners. All adult volunteers must obtain Archdiocesan clearances prior to beginning service and be willing to complete training. There will be two signup sheets in the Narthex. ## Easter Triduum




The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.
