



BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday




Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

St. Athanasius was a great theologian and Church Father. He is known as the chief defender of Trinitarianism against Arianism which advocated that the Son of God, Jesus of Nazareth, is a distinct substance from the Father.

Athanasius, the Pillar of the Church protected it from such heretical teachings. He held that not only was the Son of God consubstantial with the Father but was the Holy Spirit, which had a great deal of influence in the development of doctrines regarding the Trinity.

The Gospel reading beautifully explains our relationship with God, the source of our life. We glorify him through Jesus Christ who is always with us. He says, "I am the true vine." As children of God, we see Jesus as our master and guide. Apart from him, we cannot bear the fruits of success and happiness. Lord God of peace, hear our prayer!


