

<u>Register in the Parish</u>: Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday



following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.



celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will

be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

In today's Gospel, we hear that the teaching of Jesus on the Bread of Life sparks a wave of confusion and dissent among his followers. Many find his words harsh and unsettling. Those who heard Jesus find it difficult to understand Him and decide to reject Him.

The gospel confronts each one of us with the harsh reality: Following Jesus requires challenging our deepest assumptions, embracing discomfort, and committing to a path that may not always be comfortable. It involves questioning our beliefs, stepping out of our comfort zones, and wholeheartedly embracing a transformative journey of faith.

At the heart of the Gospel lies an undeniable truth: Jesus offers life, eternal and abundant. Yet, this life requires more than passive acceptance. It demands faith, a leap into the unknown, trusting in Christ's words even when they don't align with our earthly understanding. We must also have divine grace to leap into the unknown.

As we reflect on the bread of life, let us ask ourselves; are we willing to grapple with challenging teachings? Can we surrender our limited perspective and embrace the mystery of faith? Do we find ourselves like Peter who was drawn to Jesus despite the uncertainties, knowing He alone offers life-giving words?

Heavenly Father, grant us the courage to embrace your truth, even when it challenges us. Open our hearts to receive your life-giving words, deepen our faith, and guide us along the path to eternal life. Amen.


