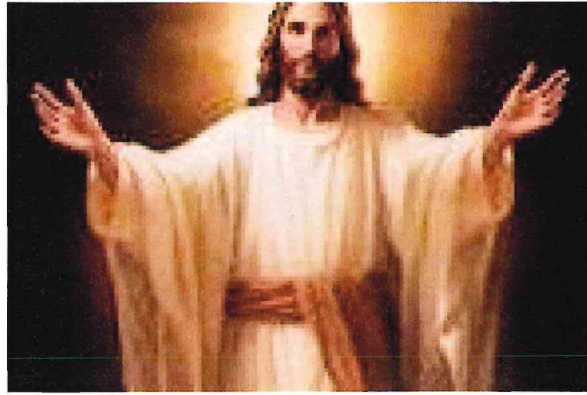


Catholic End-Of-Life Decisions and Planning
