Register in the Parish: Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

Certificates of Eligibility: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday at



11:45am (immediately following the 10:30am Mass). Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be



celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program approved by our Diocese.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office at



any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request.

We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the *Feast of St. John the Baptist.*

FROM YOUR PASTOR

In the reading today, we find God pronouncing blessings upon people for trusting in Him alone and curses them all from various infirmities for the same reason. Though a curse is something negative there is a meaningful purpose behind it, to have self-actualization in order to make our lives Christ-centered.

Thus, we are to possess and nurture His life-giving values in us. Trusting in oneself alone will make us like thistles. Though we may possess all the worldly values but trusting in Him alone we'll be like an evergreen tree around the water, growing spiritually, physically, socially and intellectually in Him.

Thus, the Kingdom signifies a new society filled with Jesus' values and the annihilation of worldly values as he blesses the poor not the poverty.

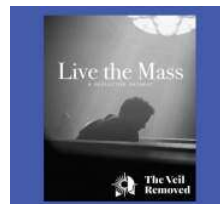
