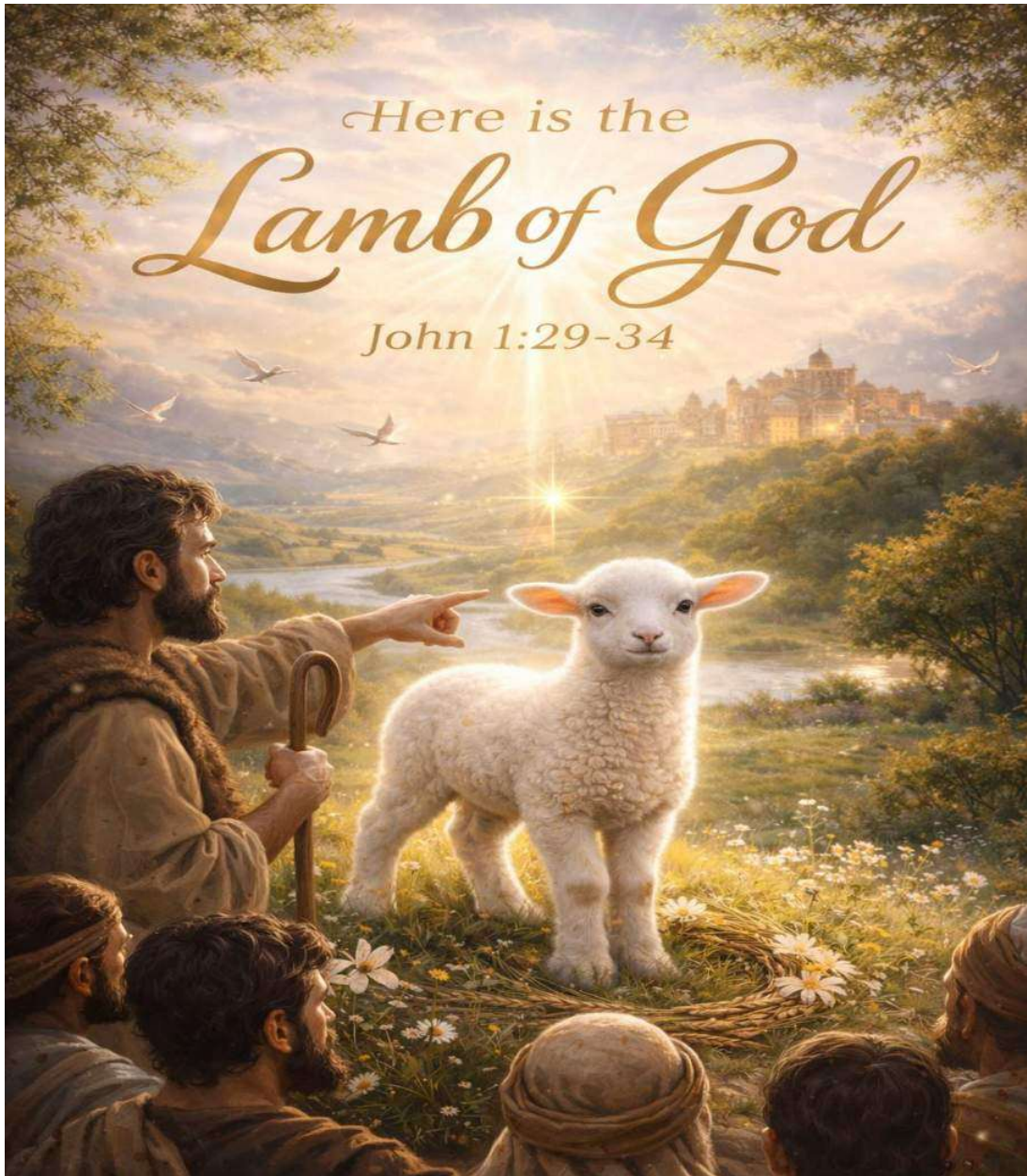

**Register in the Parish** Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

**Certificates of Eligibility** to act as Godparent or Sponsor may be issued only to registered parishioners who have been registered here at St. John the Baptist Parish at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish. If married, your marriage must have been witnessed and blessed by a Catholic Priest or have special permission approved by the Archbishop. A person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason is not eligible to be a sponsor and, therefore, we cannot issue a Certificate of Eligibility.

**BAPTISMS:** The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled



to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday at 11:45am (immediately following the 10:30am Mass). Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

**MARRIAGE:** The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be



celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program approved by our Diocese.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK**



Please call the Parish Office at any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the Feast of St. John the Baptist.

## From Your Pastor-

John fulfills his role of preparing the way of the Lord attesting Jesus as the Lamb of God who is to take away the sins of the world. He was sure that Jesus was destined to become the Passover Lamb of Sacrifice, “like a lamb that is led to the slaughter” in Isaiah.

Now Jesus’ own mission begins with the revelation of John. Very often John is pictured with one arm pointing to Jesus. It reminds us of John’s part in the gospel. It also illustrates his own self-understanding as he is to identify who Jesus is; He is “the Son of God”.

No one makes himself/herself a saint. One can lead a saintly life, but it is others who recognize and acknowledge him/her as a saint. We should recognize saints of today also to make ourselves saints by our holy and purposeful life.

We are called so that when Christ comes again, he may see his people expecting salvation through him, with and in him. John asks us to be humble in who we really are and not to boast about what we have got. We got everything freely and have to share them freely.

Reach out to the poor, the needy; proclaim the gospel to the unknown, revolt against injustices and the hardhearted and adulteries both outside and within. As Ignatius says, they use as much earthly things as they lead you to the divine and avoid them if they do not.

Lord, help us to be humble and witness you in our day-to-day lives.


