Certificates of Eligibility: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all of their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday



following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

*Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.



Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program approved by our Diocese.

## FROM YOUR PASTOR

In today's readings, the Lord calls everyone to collaborate in His salvific mission. He invites us to serve Him in a vocation unique to each of us according to the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

In the first reading, Jonah was reluctant to proclaim God's words and call the Assyrians in Nineveh to change their ways. But when he agreed to God's plan, things worked out. People in Nineveh listened to Jonah and changed their hearts and they were not punished by God.

In the second reading, Paul emphasizes the importance of contentment and faithfulness in our current circumstances. He encourages us to remain steadfast in our commitment to God, even in the face of uncertainties and worldly distractions. The call of the first disciples in Mark's Gospel tells us the significance of obedience and trust in following the path of God in executing His mission of liberation. It inspires us to heed God's call, even if it is uncertain and challenging.

All three readings show that even when it is hard, we should listen to God and follow Him. They teach us that even if we are scared or unsure, God's plan is always the best. So, we should trust Him, even when things seem tough. This can help us find our purpose and make things better for us and others.
