

<u>Register in the Parish</u>: Please contact the Parish Office

to register when you move into our parish.

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

**BAPTISMS**: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday

following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program

approved by our Diocese.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Please call the Parish Office at any time to request a visit from our Pastor for

Anointing of the Sick. Communion will

be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. **We** 

celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the Feast of St. John the Baptist.

## FROM YOUR PASTOR

In today's Gospel, after returning from the wilderness, Jesus begins teaching in the synagogues, declaring, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor." Here, Jesus identifies his mission: to serve the poor, to deliver justice to the oppressed, to heal the sick, and to release the captives.

As the world advances rapidly in various fields, the gap between the rich and the poor continues to widen. Social injustices against the oppressed are prevalent, violence is becoming very prominent, and the abuse of women, children, and vulnerable adults is on the rise. These issues persist because the awareness that all human beings are created in the image of God is slowly fading from people's minds.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds us that we were all baptized by one Spirit to form one body, whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free. This calls us to reflect on whether we have identified the mission for which we have been sent into the world. Do we truly perceive God's image in others? Do we recognize that we are all filled with one Spirit and form one body?

Heavenly Mother and Father, grant us the grace to identify our mission in the world, to see our neighbors as your reflection, and to realize that all are one body in spirit.

### Everywhere that Jesus went, the little lambs were sure to go....

The Pastoral Council is reaching out to our parishioners to see if there is interest in bringing back "The Little Lambs Club".

This was brought to our attention by a few of the focus groups last year. This club was active several years ago for children from ages 3 to 1st grade. The children should be present at the beginning of the Mass until the end of the Introductory Rites, when the priest invites them to leave for their own celebration. The children are brought back to their parents immediately after the Prayers of the Faithful by a member of the liturgy team. The children are introduced to the Gospel message and Eucharistic celebration at their own level.

We are seeking two registered parishioners to take on the leadership role for each Mass (8AM & 10:30AM) on Sunday mornings. They can be young adults, parents, or older parishioners. All adult volunteers must obtain Archdiocesan clearances prior to beginning service and be willing to complete training. This weekend there will be two signup sheets in the Narthex. One will be for anyone interested in having their children enrolled. The other will be for anyone willing to volunteer as a Little Lambs Club instructor.




