

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all of their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday



following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.



Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

Through baptism in the Church, we all are born anew in the family of God. And, by the same baptism, we are called to be the prophets. The first reading and the Gospel give guidelines of what a prophet must do. The success of a prophet is not measured by the reaction of audience but rather by his/her obedience to proclaim God's words in their presence.

In the first reading, Yahweh clearly tells the prophet Ezekiel, 'whether they listen or not' that is not his (Ezekiel's) concern. His duty is to tell them what He tells him. They are to know that there is a prophet among them. It shows the divine concern for Israel, the chosen race. In the past they have been disobedient to Him which they perpetuate. Therefore, the prophet's job is not going to be easy. But that is immaterial and what matters is deliverance of God's word.

In the Gospel, Jesus is faced with the same situation. His own people did not believe in Him. They were amazed at His deeds and wisdom but unable to believe in Him. Yet, He continues the mission of His Father. Each of us is called to obey God as prophets to establish God's Kingdom. It's a big challenge to be a prophet and in today's time it is all the more difficult. There is a lot of opposition and disagreement to God's Kingdom. One might have to pay the price of one's life but obeying God is better than any other.




