

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday

following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

FROM YOUR PASTOR

In the first reading, Amaziah told Amos, a shepherd, to flee from the land of Israel and prophesy to his people in Judah. This serves as a call for each of us to imitate Amos, prophesying both good and evil in the name of God. "Let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream." It urges us to proclaim the justice and righteousness of God, akin to flowing waters. The second reading prompts us to be thankful to God in every moment of life, even in persecution for His sake. This reflects the genuine faith of early Christians, apostles, and disciples.

In the gospel, the apostles were sent out two by two and given authority over unclean spirits, yet instructed not to carry food, a sack, or money. This encourages us to place our trust solely in God, rather than material possessions, and to detach ourselves from worldly concerns. We are given authority over unclean spirits such as envy, power, fame, and greed. Thus, we become true Disciples of Christ by living out the reign of God through justice, peace, and joy.

Dear Lord, help us to realize the power of the Holy Spirit in us to drive away unclean evil spirits internally, so that we may be led by the Spirit to spread the reign of God through our actions.

Renew our hearts and minds, so that the word which always brings us together will be "brother", and our way of life will always be that of: Shalom, Peace, Salaam! Amen.


