



From your Pastor

Today, we have for the Seventh Sunday of Easter one final passage from John's prophetic vision in the Book of Revelation. In fact, these are the final words in John's entire book that he writes to the seven churches.

We will see that John's book will end as a culmination of all that has already been proclaimed up to this point. John is not throwing together random new images and titles as if he doesn't know how to close his letter. Rather, John is very intentional in resurfacing the same images and titles that he has already introduced to emphasize who Jesus is and to press upon his readers the importance and urgency of turning to this One who is returning, to come to this One who has come and is coming again.

In short, John is making his final plea, using words both of blessing and warning, to call both believers and unbelievers to place their trust and allegiance in this soon coming King. It's a message the Spirit is speaking for us today. And in keeping with John's masterful use of numbers and their Jewish assigned meanings, we shouldn't miss the fact that this final sermon falls on the Seventh Sunday after Easter.

The number seven is the number of fullness and completeness. This is what the coming Lord holds out to us, a fullness and completeness that is only found in him. May we have ears to hear what the Lord is saying to us as we hear John's final appeal.






