

And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

(Acts of the Apostles 2: 2-4)

From your Pastor

In the First Reading the Holy Spirit manifests itself in the image of "wind." It represents the power of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit descends as 'different tongues of fire' on each one of them gathered in the house. As fire purifies, the Holy Spirit purifies them in the form of 'tongues' and gave them the gift and task of proclaiming the mighty deeds of God.

In the Gospel, Jesus breathed on the disciples and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." While for the first human being God's breath is a sign of human life; in the Gospel, Jesus' breath upon the disciples is a sign of new creation. The Second Reading highlights the functions of the Holy Spirit. He empowers the disciples with "varieties of gifts" for building up the community.

Holy Spirit is active in our life through sacraments. In baptism, we receive the Holy Spirit. We are baptized with the Holy Spirit. John the Baptist said, "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." We welcome Him through sacraments in our life. Am I aware of the working of the Holy Spirit in my life? The feast of Pentecost reminds us today of our lives in the Holy Spirit. He calls and challenges us to be true disciples of Jesus Christ and to bear witness to him.

We pray that we may open our heart and mind to the Holy Spirit so that He may sanctify, teach and guide us.





NATIVITY FEAST OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST


