
Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

### FROM YOUR PASTOR

A working mother comes home tired and weary. Seeing her small son from the playschool jumping in joy she carried him in smilingly, played with him, gave him edibles, and started the evening works. No sooner had she prepared the supper and had a bath; loud noise of the bike horn came. She opened the gate for the husband with a grin. He looked rather weak and dull. She took his baggage and asked, "Is everything fine?" He broke down in tears and shared with her the problem. She took him in her arms, and all sat for prayer. She thanked God for all the blessings, and then they sat for supper. The boy told his mother and father, "Mom, Dad, thank you."

In today's context communion is beyond enmities, frustrations, and weariness. And it seems impossible. But then when we have grateful hearts and smiling faces, we certainly can make it possible. The first reading narrates the 'enmity between the serpent and the woman, between its offspring and hers. This could be well compared with the woman's tiredness and the man's problems. In the face of all the weakness and mortality, like Paul, she does not lose heart. Jesus' enemies accuse Jesus of using the power of Satan. But Jesus conveys the power of communion with His Father.

Let us pray for ourselves saying, "Lord our loving Father and Mother, may all our daily endeavors be focused on our Spiritual Communion. We believe that You are present in every soul. We embrace You as if You were already there. Never permit us to be separated from You". Amen.






