



<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u> may be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.



From your Pastor

St. Augustine of Hippo took nearly thirty years of his matured life to write fifteen volumes called "About the Trinity". His expression was "I will not be presumptuous enough to do anything else than scratch the surface of the Trinity". In the Old Testament, God is Creator of both the world, and of the nation of Israel through whom he will bless the world.

Of course, God is present as Spirit, and the Messiah is both prophesied and foreshadowed in various manifestation. In the New Testament Gospel accounts, the emphasis is upon Jesus - his birth, baptism, message, life, death, and resurrection. But God the Father approves his Son, and the Holy Spirit descends upon Him marking the anointing of Jesus for His ministry

We derive two important lessons from Trinity. First, in the doctrine of the Trinity, we find our model for community. As God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit relate to one another, we are invited to love each other, and work in concert to accomplish the purpose of God in the world and live us one community. Secondly, in the doctrine of the Trinity, we find our mission.

Jesus stated to the disciples, "As the Father has sent me, so send I you." Just as God the Father sent Jesus into the world, so Jesus sends us into the world to do the Father's work, equipped and accompanied by the Spirit of God.

We, the baptized Christians, become a "temple of the Holy Spirit and adopted child of the Father in virtue of the communication of the Spirit (Gal 4:6)." Baptized Christians are the people of the Trinity. Baptized persons become the property of Christ, and also symbolically plunged into Christ himself (Rom 6:3). Let us live by the Spirit according to the will of God through Jesus' values.




