

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all of their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday

following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a


Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

The Gospel reading reveals to us God's mysterious ways of establishing His Kingdom, like the growth of the seed. There are familiar metaphors used here, such as the seed, plant, tree, mountain and birds unfolding realistically the qualities and the aspects of the Kingdom of God. The seed is small and full of life. The plant is the visible growth of the seed. The tree is fully grown to give shade and shelter. The birds enjoy the fruit and the shelter. All these describe the wonders of God's Kingdom.

The readings focus the on eschatological period, calling us to reflect on the mysterious growth of God's Kingdom here and now. How do we recognize it amidst the multifaceted society is a challenging task. Given the obstacles we face from political, religious, and socio-economic issues which are not so hope giving, we might lose hope. And yet, we need to see the invisible things happening in and around us. St. Paul invites us in the second reading that we need 'to live by faith and not by sight'.

The role that we need to play is to assist in the growth of the faith and allow the divine grace to flow into the lives of many by being with the people in hopelessness, misery and sufferings. It is only by our hope that we may enjoy like birds of the air, the blessings of God. We can only be the hope of the hopeless if we live and act in hope.




