





### FROM YOUR PASTOR

The movie 'Silence' is about two 17<sup>th</sup> century Portuguese missionaries who went to Japan. Amidst the cruel persecution and torture of the Christians, they cry out to God for help. But they don't see any direct intervention of God in that situation and the persecution continues. The movie ends with a piercing question: "God, are you silent or are we praying to silence?".

The Psalmist had the same lament in Psalm 44: 23-24 – "Rouse yourself! Why do you sleep, O Lord? Awake, do not cast us off forever! Why do you hide your face? Why do you forget our affliction and oppression?"

In the Gospel we see Jesus fast asleep in the boat when the disciples were terrified that the boat was going to break up due to the storm. The story highlights the stormy journey our faith has to make. In the present scenario, we are facing trouble from different groups. In such situations, our faith in Jesus is drowned by fear and we start doubting His presence amidst us. We need to remind ourselves that in such times Jesus may be asleep in our boat, but His love never leaves us. The real calmness disciples experienced, not in the sea but in their hearts, was when they realized Jesus was with them all the time.

God, life's storms hit unexpectedly and toss me into a sea of chaos, doubt and anxiety. When the waves threaten to drown my little boat, Lord make me aware that I have You with me as my precious passenger. Let me hear Your voice saying: 'Peace, be still'.

Renew our hearts and minds, so that the word which always brings us together will be "brother", and our way of life will always be that of: Shalom, Peace, Salaam! Amen.
