

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday at



11:45am (immediately following the 10:30am Mass). Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another

parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.



celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program

approved by our Diocese.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office at



any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request.

We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the Feast of St. John the Baptist.





From your Pastor

Some time ago a national magazine carried an article about lucky people. It began by pointing out that some people seem to get all the breaks, while other people seem to get none of the breaks. It is said that lucky people are often the cause of their good luck, while unlucky people are the cause of their bad luck. Lucky people have an upbeat attitude. They are people who are positive and affirming. Above all, they are people who have a talent for focusing on the good side of things, especially the good side of other people.

In contrast, unlucky people have a downbeat attitude. They are people who are negative and hostile. Above all, they are people who have the habit of focusing on the bad side of everything, especially the bad side of people. They are people who are prone to criticize. They are people who are prone to find fault.

They are the kind of people Jesus is talking about in today's Gospel. When He says, "why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? He is indicating the shallowness of a person's character to relate freely with other people. We ourselves have been the object of observation as well. Therefore, let us stop judging others. As our beloved Pope says, who am I to judge?




