


**BAPTISMS:** The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a



Sunday following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must

provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1nm on Saturdays.

#### A Prayer for the People of the Ukraine

#### From your Pastor

Today we celebrate the Pentecost Sunday. In the first reading, we see the dramatic episode of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and its effects on the Apostles. In the second reading, St Paul tells how the varieties of the gifts of the Holy Spirit are for the common good. In the Gospel, Jesus strengthens the Apostles, who frightened of the Jews, by greeting them with peace and by giving assurance of the Holy Spirit. He also asks the apostles to forgive the sins of others. The gifts of understanding, peace, willingness to forgive and seeking forgiveness are some of the graces we can ask from the Holy Spirit today.

As believers, we need the gifts of the Holy Spirit. It is to build up the community and bring unity. It must not be used for selfish purposes or to bring glory to oneself because the varieties of gifts come from the same Holy Spirit.

Many countries in the world need peace. Violence in several parts of the world has brought chaos and confusion. In our own country, people live with fear and confusion because of the rising hate politics. Amidst these circumstances, when we celebrate the feast of Pentecost today, let us pray earnestly that the Holy Spirit may dwell among the people and let there be peace among us.




