

FROM YOUR PASTOR

The first reading tells us how God envisioned men and women to be partners, particularly in the context of marriage. The Hebrew word 'ezer' was used to describe the woman as 'helper'. Now, 'ezer' appears 21 times in the Bible, out of which 16 times it is used to show God as the helper and savior. The usage of the word 'ezer' gives a better understanding of how men and women ought to relate to each other. By all means, it does not mean that women are subordinate to men. Men and women are unique and different as they are, yet they complement each other. Husband and wife thus complement each other. In no way, either of them is subordinate to the other.

In the Gospel, we read that Jesus when confronted with the question of divorce upholds the sanctity of marriage and alludes to the point that marriage was part of the creation. In doing so He affirms the presence of the Divine in the institution of marriage. Therefore, He says, "what God has joined together, let no one separate". Marriage is a covenant, and it entails commitment and sacrifice.

Today there are more and more broken marriages due to the lack of commitment and sacrifice. The second reading speaks of hope and shows us how Jesus endured sufferings to bring about salvation. Jesus suffered because He loved us. Likewise, when the marriage partners love each other, it would surely involve pain and suffering, but with the grace of God, the partners in marriages, too, would be able to endure any suffering and flourish in their lives.
