

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all of their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday

following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. **We celebrate a**

FROM YOUR PASTOR

Today's readings remind us of the inclusive nature of God. God who is present in history and who is also present in chaos prepares a rich banquet and invites all to the banquet. In the first reading, God destroyed all that sought to oppress the people. He also would host a feast with rich and the most luxurious food possible - fat dishes filled with marrow as well as well-aged distilled wines. The others are also given the same hope. Thus, God's feast is not only for the Israelites but also for all people.

In the reading from the gospel, Jesus prepares a wedding dinner and invites all to the feast. Initially, the invited people just ignored the invitation and refused to attend. They go about their business when they are called a second time. In a rage, the king dispatches his forces to destroy both the offenders and their city.

Finally, the king sends his servant into the streets to invite everyone, good and bad, to the wedding feast. They invite everyone in and fill the hall. The last invitation, which fills the banquet hall, is open to all. When the king encounters a guest who is not properly attired, the king sends him out of the banquet. Though God gives his grace to all without any condition, our acceptance of His grace should be reflected in our way of life to take part in the eternal Kingdom.


