

<u>Register in the Parish</u>: Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday



following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be



celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office at

any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will

be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request.

We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the *Feast of St. John the Baptist*.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

Laws, rituals, regulations and ceremonies are often good. But they are not absolute. Often, they harden and become irrelevant and no longer lead anyone to God, rather they become a hindrance.

The Pharisees and the scribes practiced man-made traditions and did not give praise to God. Their hearts have strayed away from God and clung to man-made traditions. They were hypocrites to the core in their actions and words and showed themselves as impeccable and pious in the eyes of society. They embraced human traditions more than divine love and were insincere in their worship.

Jesus presents a new understanding of our new life, our relationship with God and worship. The older idea of religion emphasized external piety while the new stressed interior piety. Jesus says we need to worship God in spirit and in truth. God is spirit and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth. One must worship God with one's heart and soul. This will lead to a far more intimate seeking with Him, and in the right way. Hence, we need to be aware of religious practices. They are just human regulations. Such religious practices should not be practiced or enforced as if God ordained them. Rituals and religious ceremonies, laws and regulations ultimately lead us towards a just relationship with other fellow beings and God.

Lord, help us to follow sincerely your divine laws - loving God and neighbor faithfully without putting limits.


