Register in the Parish: Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

Certificates of Eligibility: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a *Certificate of Eligibility* from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.



MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays. Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana program approved by our Diocese.



ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office at any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. We celebrate a Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the *Feast of St. John the Baptist*.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

In the first reading prophet Isaiah prophesies about the Messiah when there were crises in Israel. They were longing for a messiah. Isaiah mentions that the blind and deaf will be healed. Their eyes and ears will recognize God's acts when the Messiah comes. He assures Israel proclaiming, that the Messiah will come and save, and there will be peace and justice in God's kingdom.

In today's Gospel, we see the fulfillment of God's kingdom. Jesus does his ministry by preaching and healing. The second reading shows the present situation of society where people are carried away by favoritism. James makes clear that in God's kingdom rich and poor both are equal and rich in faith are to be heirs in the kingdom of God.

Taking the man apart from the crowd, Jesus performed a ritual of healing then Jesus prayed to God. Jesus was compassion for the man. Jesus cures a person who was fully away from the human society. He was deaf, dumb and blind, which made him completely stay away from the people. By healing him, Jesus makes him part of society. It shows that in God's kingdom, everyone is equal whether poor or rich.


