

<u>Register in the Parish</u>: Please contact the Parish Office to register when you move into our parish.

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

BAPTISMS: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday



following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

program approved by our Diocese.

FROM YOUR PASTOR

In today's world, balancing faith in God is challenging for us Christians. The distractions of daily life often wear away and erode our beliefs. It's important to remind ourselves of the sacraments we have received and commit to pursuing our faith without compromise.

Actions speak louder than words. The three readings of today clearly state the necessity of having an active faith and a willingness to endure challenges for the sake of God's will. Mere words are insufficient unless we turn them into action. Genuine faith prompts deeds of compassion and kindness. Faith, when alive, produces tangible actions.

In the Gospel, Jesus questions his disciples about his identity. Peter responds that Jesus is the Christ. When informed about Jesus' suffering and death, Peter rebukes him. However, Jesus emphasizes the cost discipleship. That's a challenge for us. Taking up one's cross and following Jesus isn't easy. Therefore, engaging in daily personal prayer, participating in the Holy Eucharist, and devotion to Mother Mary will lead us to strengthen our faith. The common thread is a call to live out our faith, trusting God amidst difficulties, and showing our commitment through compassionate actions and selfsacrifice.

Let us pray - Lord Jesus, strengthen our faith as we embark on this journey guided by your word. May our hearts be open to the truths of the Gospel. Help us to trust in your promises and guide us on the challenging path to tread in your name.


