

<u>Certificates of Eligibility</u>: May be issued only to registered parishioners who currently reside within our parish boundaries, who have been registered parishioners at least six months, are 16 yrs. and older, who have received all of their Sacraments of Initiation, and are actively practicing their faith in our parish.

**BAPTISMS**: The Sacrament of Baptism may be scheduled to take place on a Saturday at 10am or 11am; or on a Sunday

following at 11:45am. Parents and at least one Godparent are to attend our Enrichment class prior to the Baptism. You will need to call the Parish Office to register for this class. Godparents must be committed, practicing Catholics, over the age of 16, and if from another parish, must provide a

Certificate of Eligibility from their pastor. A Christian of another denomination may serve as a Christian Witness alongside a Catholic Godparent.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony Mass may be celebrated no later than 1pm on Saturdays.

Couples planning marriage are to contact the Parish Office & schedule a meeting with our Pastor no later than 6 months in advance of the planned wedding date. Couples are to attend a Pre-Cana

program approved by our Diocese.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish Office at



any time to request a visit from our Pastor for Anointing of the Sick. Communion will be brought to the sick and homebound by our Pastor or one of our Communion Ministers upon request. **We celebrate a** 

Communal Anointing of the Sick in June, near the Feast of St. John the Baptist.

# FROM YOUR PASTOR

The Lord is inviting us to be close to him. He invites us today in a beautiful way through the readings, and he promises us a rightful place for those who respond to his invitation.

It is said in the first reading, "Seek the Lord while he may be found, call upon him while he is near; let the wicked forsake their ways, and the unrighteous their thoughts; let them return to the Lord, for he will abundantly pardon." The nature of God's tenderness and love for humankind is portrayed through these words. It is again emphasized with the words 'for my thoughts are not your thoughts, not are your ways my ways'. It is hard and difficult for us humans to pardon another person in the same measure as what God is promising us today. God's ways are not our ways. We experience this through the gospel reading.

Jesus brings in the parable of the laborers in the vineyard. The landowner went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard. But at the end of the day, all were given equal pay as promised. Apparently, it is unjust in the eyes of the world. The world will reward graded pay to the hired workers according to the number of hours they work. But this is not the way God works. He promises salvation to those who respond to his invitation.


